## **2. Remit of the Members**

The Members have an overview of the governance arrangements of the Trust and have the power to appoint and remove Trustees (Directors/Governors).

## **3. Remit of the Governing Board (Board of Trustees/Directors)**

The purpose of the Governing Board is to work with the school to raise standards of achievement for all pupils. This involves providing a strategic view for the school, acting as a critical friend and ensuring accountability. The individual trustee has a responsibility, working alongside other members of the governing board, to the staff and pupils of the school, the school's wider community and where they are representatives, to their particular constituency (parents; staff; teachers; etc). Although some trustees may represent particular constituencies they are not delegates of that group.

There are three core tasks that Trustees undertake:

- i. Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- ii. Holding the Headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils, and the performance management of staff; and
- iii. Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.

Trustees' responsibilities include:

- Developing the strategic plan for the school
- Determining aims, policies and priorities of the school
- Setting statutory and non statutory targets
- Monitoring and evaluating the work of the school
- Appointment of staff and ensuring the implementation of a range of personnel procedures
- Management of the budget
- Securing high levels of attendance and good standards of pupil behaviour
- Ensuring that all children in the school have access to a broad and balanced curriculum which is suitable to age, aptitude and ability, which prepares them for adult life
- Ensuring the health and safety of pupils and staff

## **3. Sub-Committee Structure**

### **Admissions**

The role of the Admissions Committee is to review and make decisions regarding applications for admission, to monitor the admissions processes and manage the admissions appeal process. *This is now a standing item on the Agenda for the Full Governing Board meetings – an Extraordinary Admissions Committee will be called when required.*

### **Finance, Audit and Risk (Chair: TBA)**

The role of the Finance, Audit and Risk Committee is to monitor the effectiveness of management in ensuring the on-going financial viability of the School and incorporates the functions of an audit and risk committee.
