

Information on Admission Tests for Universities.

Bishopshalt School is an authorised test centre for the following examinations. As you cannot register yourself, you will need to see Mrs Fantham in order to enter for a test.

The registration starts on 1st September and closes on 1st October.

BMAT – BioMedical Admissions Test for several universities.

2 hr test Aptitude and Skills, Scientific Knowledge and Applications and Writing Task.

ELAT – English Literature pre-interview admissions test for Oxford.

1hr 30min test on key skill of close reading.

HAT – History Aptitude for Oxford entrance.

2hr test subject specific.

MAT – Maths Admissions for Oxford entrance and Imperial College London

2hr 30min test subject specific.

PAT - Physics Aptitude for Oxford entrance required for all Engineering, Materials Science and Physics courses. 2hr subject specific.

STEP – Maths Sixth Term Exam Paper for Cambridge entrance. May be asked for by other universities. 3hr test.

All of the above tests are sat in school at the beginning of November except for the STEP which is taken in June.

There is a charge for BMAT and STEP but no charge for the others.

The following tests are taken at a test centre outside of school please see the website for further details:

LNAT – Law National Aptitude Test. 1hr 35min multiple choice and 40min written essay question. Can be taken between September and June in Year 13.

UKCAT – UK Clinical Aptitude test for Medicine or Dentistry. Can be taken between 1st July and 6th October.
