



Year 11 and 13 Assessment Plan

The following plan has been written to show parents and students how we will teach and assess Years 11 and 13 in the forthcoming weeks. Departments will build up a portfolio of evidence from existing classwork, homework, assessments, practicals and exams. The following 2 assessment opportunities are not on their own designed to formulate a grade but assist in the evidence portfolio the school is collecting to enable us to gain as accurate a profile of each student as we can. A top or bottom ranking grade in the assessment does not automatically mean a student will receive this grade in a particular subject but it will be used along with all other available evidence to determine the final award.

Please be aware that teachers are not allowed to discuss with parents the grade that a student has been given.

Please be we are still awaiting guidance/confirmation from the government regarding when Years 11 and 13 will no longer be required to attend school. We will inform parents and students of this date in due course.
