Dear Parents & Carers

Re: Coronavirus / COVID-19 Positive Case

I am writing to inform you that we have unfortunately been advised of our first reported positive case of COVID-19 within our school community. The parents' of the student alerted us today, and we would like to reassure you that the student concerned has not been in school for seven school days, since Friday 11th September.

In accordance with Public Health England and DfE procedure, we have report this to them and have followed the guidance that they have provided. They have advised us to continue to operate the school as we are.

We would like to reassure you that the student has been isolating since symptoms commenced ten days ago and has not been in school since. The student was not infectious whilst in school and will not be back until they have finished their isolation period and have had two consecutive days without a temperature in excess of 37.8.

In accordance with our internal procedures for dealing with a positive COVID-19 case, we are 'tracking and tracing' all students that potentially could have been in contact with the student concerned. When we identify these students, we will contact those families directly to ask that they monitor their children for any of the key symptoms;

- a high temperature in excess of 37.8.
- a new, continuous cough - this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 (if you usually have a cough – it may be worse than usual.)
- a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste – this means you have noticed that you cannot smell or taste anything, or taste or smell things differently

We appreciate that you will be worried by this information; unfortunately it is highly likely that this will not be the last case we have. Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

The school will continue to monitor the situation and will remain open following all guidance provided by Public Health, England and the DfE.
