Year 12 Enterprise Day will be taking place on Friday 18th October 2019 at Brunel University. The details for the day are as follows and are also outlined in the Sixth Form Handbook which was given to students at the start of term:-

Each year we run an Enterprise Challenge event for our Sixth Form students. We are very fortunate to have been offered the facilities at Brunel University for the day.

Our students will be working in teams with professionals and students from Brunel University and local businesses on a range of team building and problem solving tasks. They will be able to use the newly refurbished student canteen for their lunch, where a large range of food is offered at reasonable prices. Students who usually have a meal ticket should see their Head of Year in advance for a voucher.

On Friday 18th October, all students will be required to arrive in school at 8.20am for an 8.30am departure; assemble in the main hall foyer, after which we shall all walk to Brunel University to arrive and be ready to start work at 9.00am in the Hamilton Centre. Students will be expected to make their own way home from Brunel University when the event ends at approximately 3.45pm.

This day provides our students with some excellent experiences and skills to enhance any future university or job application. It also allows us to observe potential Prefects who display the requisite leadership skills. Attendance is compulsory and absences will be recorded in the usual way. Whilst our usual high standards of punctuality and behaviour are expected, the dress code is smart professional; students do not need to wear ties or suits, but as part of the day their team will be assessed on professionalism, which includes their conduct and appearance.
