Dear Parents and Students

Re: Year 12 'Safe Drive Stay Alive' Performance: Tuesday 26th November 2019

Bishopshalt Year 12 students have been invited to attend a theatre trip to watch 'Safe Drive Stay Alive' at the Winston Churchill Hall in Ruislip. The production is a joint initiative with Transport for London and the Hillingdon Road Safety team. Its aim is to reduce the disproportionate number of road casualties among young road users. The facts are shocking, on average one in five young people will crash their car in the first year of driving and they are most likely to have people of their own age as passengers. The threat of young people being killed or seriously injured on the roads is unsurpassed; in fact no other cause comes close. As Director of Sixth Form, I can confirm that Bishopshalt School is not exempt from this frightening statistic.

I am sure that all parents will support this important initiative and work with us to prevent premature deaths on the roads. The production is 'hard hitting, truthful and incredibly engaging'.

The performance and transport are both free to Bishopshalt students. Students must register in their form rooms at the normal time of 8.40am. Coaches will transport students to and from the event on **Tuesday 26th November 2019, departing school at 9.10am and returning circa 12.10pm**. Students will return to lessons as normal for Periods 4 and 5 in the afternoon.

Students will be accompanied by members of the Sixth Form teaching staff during the journey and at the performance. All students must wear seatbelts at all times throughout the entire journey to and from the venue. Whilst at the event, students will be expected to conduct themselves in a way befitting a theatre audience and student at Bishopshalt School.

All students are insured under the school's personal accident policy throughout the duration of this educational visit.

I am sure you will agree with me that this is an excellent opportunity for your child to enhance their road safety awareness and reduce the threat of young people being killed or seriously injured on the roads.
